MT. TRIALS

The Mt. Trials offers a refreshing change in the mountain bike world. This bike is capable of taking your riding skills to a new level of expertise and will do exactly what you tell it to. Whether you ride mainly on the road (this is the criterium bike of mountain bikes), on rough trails, singletrack, slickrock or fireroads, the IBIS Mt. Trials is the most fun and responsive bike you could choose for the task at hand.

Don't let the name fool you. The Mt. Trials is a mountain bike, not a trials bike. Although originally designed as a bike for trials competition, the Mt. Trials has become our favorite all around bike. (In the old days we rode this bike to three top ten finishes in the Pro class at the NORBA Trials Nationals.) We've ridden it in the rain forests of the Pacific Northwest (log hop central). We've hopped around in our front yard (the neighbors think we're weird, but they're glad we haven't ridden over their cars). We've had the maximum dose of fun on slickrock — any more fun would probably be illegal — and we've ridden it on the longest mountain bike rides, with a few log and rock long cuts thrown in just to make the other riders jealous.

The Mt. Trials is shorter and steeper than other mountain bikes. The front wheel is 26", the rear 24" (there are now several good 24" tires to choose from). The chainstays are 15". The top

tube is 22.75". Tie this to a 72 degree headtube angle and you have one responsive ride. It comes in 2 sizes: 13.5", to accommodate riders up to 5'8", and 17" for taller riders. All of the tubes on this bike are bigger than on the average bike. "This is no SKINNY PUPPY." The top tube and seat tube are 11/4". The seat post is a rather portly 29.4mm. The down tube is 13/8" for a torsionally stiff (i.e. precise) front end. The fork, built with either Koski or Ritchey blades, completes the fastidious front end design.

As with every Ibis, we offer you options in several areas. The raw frames are built in our Sebastopol factory on a limited production basis. When we receive your order, we install the braze ons that you choose. Then we apply one of our beautiful polyurethane enamel paint jobs. In addition to more than a dozen stock paint configurations available, you may also choose to design your own custom paint. Then it's time to decide on components. Whether you fancy a complete group from one manufacturer or a conglomeration of the latest, lightest most exotic components, Ibis can fill the bill. We also offer a milled outer chainring (which acts as a rock protector) as an option in case you want to use this bike as a hybrid trials/mountain bike.

This is the year to step up, to "Chuck Your Slug," and opt for the sport bike of the year.


